Guidance Document for persons organising IPA branded events in countries other than their own

- 1. Anyone intending to organise an event, such as a sporting competition, using the IPA's name and logos in countries other than their own, must first:
 - a. Provide evidence that their own national section supports the event;
 - b. Inform promptly the national section of the country where it is intended to organise the event, and ask for their consent.
- 2. If the national section concerned refuses their consent, the event may take place, but without the involvement of the local IPA regions and branches, and the IPA name and logo must not be used.
- 3. If the national section concerned grants their consent, the event will take place in cooperation with that section, which will be involved as much as they deem appropriate.
- 4. In case of non-compliance with the above, or in the case of repetition of non-regulated behaviour, following IEB notification, the national section of the member concerned may take disciplinary action as deemed appropriate.
- 5. Individual or group travel to other countries by IPA members is covered under the Procedure for Travel Assistance.

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
