Dear Murad

As pointed out in my letter dated June 4 2019, the IEB discussed the status of 'Section in Foundation' for Uzbekistan during its last meeting.

Due to the fact that we have not seen any significant evidence of positive IPA development in your country over the last few years, and that there has been a lack of effective communication, we took the decision - in accordance with our international documents - to withdraw the status of 'Section in Foundation' for Uzbekistan. Section Russia, as your sponsor section, will receive a copy of this letter, and we will also inform all IPA sections in due course.

I am aware that this is not positive news for you, but the IEB felt that this decision was in the best interest of the IPA. As specified in our documents, current IPA members in Uzbekistan may remain in the association as Foreign Associate Members of IPA Russia, providing the Russian section gives their approval. Of course you may wish to restart the affiliation process in the future, but this would have to be based on a clear understanding about what the IPA is, and what conditions need to be fulfilled to become an IPA section.

I must also inform you that the withdrawal of the status of 'Section in Foundation' means that your attendance at the forthcoming IPA World Congress in Croatia, should you choose to participate, must be now authorised by me, as you would only be able to attend as guests, and not as observers. I am happy to grant you this authorisation, provided that you forward a request to me as soon as possible, so that IPA Croatia can take it into consideration, as the deadline for registrations has already passed.

I regret that it has not been possible to reach a more positive conclusion for now, and I sincerely hope that we will be able to restart the process of integrating Uzbekistan into the IPA in the near future, under better circumstances. Thank you for your understanding.
